The James Conner Courage Award

The James Conner Courage Award

The inaugural "James Conner Courage Award" was named in honor of Pittsburgh Steeler running back James Conner.

It was in 2015, when James heard the words "you have cancer." A biopsy revealed Stage 2 Hodgins Lymphoma.

At that time, James was a star running back with the University of Pittsburgh Panthers football team, breaking records and leading his team in rushing yards. An avid Pitt Panthers fan, Dr. Stanley Marks was faced with not only helping this young man beat his cancer but ensuring his successful return to the football field.

Dr. Marks would say his work was easy.

James fought his cancer the same way he played football - relentlessly and without surrender. He refused to miss Pitt's spring football practice and wore a surgical mask to avoid illness as he pushed himself during the drills. His teammates coined the phrase "Conner Strong" to demonstrate their support. His strength to survive and work tirelessly on the football field, attracted the attention of the Pittsburgh Steelers, who drafted him in 2017.



It was that drive, that heart, that spirit, that courage that inspired this award.

At UPMC Hillman Cancer Center, we are inspired daily by those who face cancer without fear but with determination.

They are the inspiration for the Stanley M. Marks Golf Classic "James Conner Courage Award" as it will forever mark the strength and courage of those who face cancer.

ed. The transplant was not easy, but it worked.

First patient in UPMC Hillman-developed clinical trial

On any given day, you will find Cathy Doyle happily playing with and caring for her four grandchildren. Her entire family, which includes her two children, their spouses, her husband and her nine brothers and sisters are extremely close and most live nearby right in the Pittsburgh region.

That family rallied around Cathy when four years ago, she was fighting for her life following a diagnosis of Acute Myeloid Leukemia (AML), a rare type of blood cancer that forms in the bone marrow and rapidly progresses.

Unfortunately, Cathy was no stranger to cancer – she had already overcome ovarian cancer a few years earlier. With this diagnosis, her Hillman oncologist/hematologist, Dr. Annie Im, recommended she undergo an allogeneic stem team cell transplant, which requires a stem cell donor who is a close genetic match. Patients sometimes struggle to find donors, but since Cathy came from a large family, she had choices. Every single one of her family members volunteered to be tested and two brothers were 100% matches. It was her younger brother, Michael Ragan, who was a full match and became her donor. Ragan never hesitat-

Cathy spent a month at UPMC Shadyside receiving high doses of chemotherapy to kill the cancer cells and another month following a stem cell transplant, which replaces the destroyed stem cells in the bone marrow.

Despite the stem cell match, stem cell transplants can also have complications, one of which is called graft-versus-host disease or GVHD. GVHD occurs when the donor's T cells inadvertently attack the patient's healthy cells. It can be mild, moderate, or severe – and in some cases, life-threatening.

Preventing GVHD is a focus of UPMC Hillman Cancer Center researcher, Dr. Warren Shlomchik, and Cathy was the first person at UPMC selected for his clinical trial. The initial trial was so successful in reducing the risk of GVHD and in preventing cancer recurrence, that the trial has been expanded to a multicenter, national trial.

Cathy frequently calls herself blessed and lucky. She does not complain. She believes she was blessed to find Dr. Im and her oncology team, to be the first person in a new clinical trial at UPMC Hillman Cancer Center, and blessed for the wonderful nurses and a loving family who cared for her.

"She is one of a kind," Dr. Im said. "She never once said 'why me?' She approached every treatment with a positive, faithful, hopeful, and gracious spirit."

Today, Cathy helps other patients by talking with them about her clinical trial and her experiences. She keeps in contact with many of the nurses who cared for her and she is enjoying her life while running after her four grandchildren.

Cathy Doyle, the 2021 James Conner Courage Award recipient, is a positive, fun loving, and caring woman who refuses to give in to cancer.



Bob Pompeani

Bob Pompeani began his career at KDKA-TV in 1982, but his experience with hometown sports goes beyond the 39 years he's worked at KDKA AS Sports Director and lead Sports Anchor.

Growing up in an area deep in sports traditions, Bob has seen all of the biggest high school rivalries as well as met players and coaches who've gone on to make sports history.

Bob spends the school year presenting the KDKA-TV "Extra Effort" award to local students who excel in athletics, academics and community service. He has done this for 34 years

For the last 22 years, Bob has done the pre-season play by play for Steelers Pre-Season Football

In 1997 Bob was voted Pittsburgh's favorite sportscaster in a reader poll of the Pittsburgh Post-Gazette. In 1998, Bob became the first man ever to receive the Pittsburgh Beauty Academy's Professional Image Award — in the twenty years that PBA has handed out the honor.

He has been voted "Best Sportscaster for the last ten years in a row by Pittsburgh Magazine

Bob was also the 2000 Tri-State PGA of America Distinguished Service Award winner for outstanding contributions to local golf — getting inducted into the local Tri-State PGA Golf Hall of Fame.

Bob was inducted into the Beaver County Sports Hall of Fame in April of 2007 for his many contributions to local sports.

Bob has received the Golden Quill Award six times: first in 1987 for his report, "Earning Their Stripes," a story about hockey officiating; second in 1988 for "Project Playoffs"; and most recently in 2019 for his Pittsburgh Steeler exclusives.

Bob has won three Mid-Atlantic Emmy awards and eight AP awards for play-by-play of Steeler Pre-Season games and as host of the "#1 Cochran Sports Showdown."

In 2011, Bob was named "Father of the Year" by the National Father's Day Council, and in 2012 he was awarded a People's Choice Award for "Dancing With Pittsburgh Celebrities."

In 2015 Bob was also awarded with a lifetime achievement award by the Syria Shriners of Pittsburgh.

In 2015 Bob was inducted into the Pennsylvania Sports Hall of Fame.

After graduating from Hopewell High School, Bob graduated from Point Park University with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Broadcast Journalism and a minor in Political Science.

In between work and family time, Bob works closely with the community and is on the board of directors for the American Heart Association, Cystic Fibrosis Foundation and Partners for Quality Inc, AHN Board of Directors and the Give the Kids the World Foundation.

Bob and his wife, Lisa, reside in Robinson Township

They have two daughters Chelsea and Celina. And two grand daughters Ellie and Faith!!
